

### FUNDING - REVIEW OF NATIONAL SECRETARIAT PROGRAM

#### **PURPOSE**

- 1. The purpose of this brief is to:
  - advise you of steps taken to manage current issues regarding funding of peak bodies by the National Secretariat Program (NSP); and
  - inform you of progress on the Review of the NSP 2004.

#### KEY ISSUES/SUMMARY

- 2. The NSP was created in 2001 to streamline and improve administration of peak body funding. Previously funding was dispersed across FaCS.
- 3. A scheduled review of the program is in progress. The review is drawing on consultation undertaken with peak organisations in 2003-04 and is expected to be finalised in late October 2004.
- 4. Current improvements in the NSP include implementing a consistent and outcome focused Funding Agreement with the peak bodies. However, some administrative issues have resulted in delays in finalising the 2004-05 Funding Agreements with the peak bodies, and the NSP review.

6. As part of the review, work is currently underway to clarify the rationale for funding under NSP (frequent requests for funding are received from organisations outside the NSP), strengthen administrative processes, bolster the NSP's contribution to FaCS policy directions and scope out strategies for managing the range of peaks funded.

7. In the interim a letter to peak bodies (see **Attachment A**) will be sent introducing key new staff in the FaCS NSP management and team, and advise the peak bodies on progress on the review.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 8. The NSP was created in 2001 at the direction of the then Minister for Family and Community Services. It provides streamlined funding administration for twenty-one national peak bodies (see **Attachment B** for details) to facilitate two-way communication between government and the community on social policy issues.
- 9. Prior to this there were many different approaches to funding, and steps have been taken to address this.
- 10. A review was foreshadowed at its inception by the then Minister for Family and Community Services. Consultation for this review was undertaken in 2003-04, building on previous reviews and studies into funding of peak bodies.
- 11. Under the auspices of the revised NSP two new umbrella peaks were established Families Australia and the Australian Federation of Disability Organisations. Improvements in the NSP include efforts to distinguish different contributions by peak organisations through tiered funding, implementation of outcome focused standard funding agreements, and building stronger relationships with peak organisations.


