Description	The procurement will be a single stage open market tender approach via a Request for Tender (RFT), for a contract that is planned to be for an initial period of five (5) years with an option to extend for a further five (5) years.
	The procurement is to engage a Supplier to deliver Bali Lifetime Rehabilitation Assistance Package (Bali LAP) services from 1 January 2025, immediately following the expiration of the current contract on 31 December 2024. The contract will include a transition in period from November 2024 which will be important for the existing Active Customers in the case of a new provider.
	The new service provider will be required to administer BaliLAP on behalf of the Department, and maintain support for the less than 10 Active Customers. This includes ongoing case management, individual assessments, and reimbursement of approved costs for rehabilitation care.
	The Department needs to ensure certainty for the ongoing arrangements for Active Customers. The annual plans for Active Customers include approval to purchase goods and services and seek immediate reimbursement. Any gap in service delivery would be too great a risk for the ongoing management of clients' health and wellbeing. Any gap in service provision is likely to result in reputational damage for the provider, the department and Government.
