

APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM ATM WITHDRAWAL LIMIT

A person who occupies gaming machine premises as defined under the *National Gambling Reform Act 2012* may apply for the premises to be exempt from the requirement to limit the amount of cash that can be withdrawn from an automatic teller machine (ATM) on those premises.

This is the approved form under s 43(2) of the National Gambling Reform Act.
